Membership

The Parking and Traffic Committee shall consist of the chief of University Police, who will serve as chair; two faculty representatives; one University Police representative in addition to the committee chair; one Physical Plant representative; one Athletics representative; one Financial Affairs representative; and three students. Faculty representative will serve 2 year terms. If a committee member would like to serve an additional term. They must send their request to the Chair. The Chair will add the request to the last meeting's agenda. The committee will vote on allowing the committee member to serving an additional term.

Function

The Parking and Traffic Committee has two primary functions. First, the committee serves as a judicial board to hear and rule on appeals of Lander University parking and traffic citations and towing charges. In addition, the committee reviews traffic and parking regulations and makes recommendations to the president regarding all aspects of the parking policy and parking facilities of the university.

Procedures

The committee meets periodically at the call of its chair.

Approved minutes will be sent to the President, the Vice Presidents, the Chair of Faculty Senate, and the Student Government Association President.

The committee reports to the Student Life Council.
