Curriculum Committee (2026-2027)

Reports To Faculty Senate

Membership

The Curriculum Committee will consist of the following four non-voting members: the Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs (or designee), the President of the Student Government Association (or designee), the Dean of the College of Graduate and Online Studies (or designee) and a designee from the Registrar. The Curriculum Committee will also consist of three faculty senator voting members. The three voting faculty senators must come from different colleges. If a college is not represented on the Curriculum Committee by a faculty senator, the dean(s) of the unrepresented college(s) may appoint an additional voting faculty member to the Curriculum Committee from their respective college to serve for the academic year. The chair of the Curriculum Committee must be a tenured faculty member currently serving as a faculty senator. The chair will be appointed either by self-nomination or elected from the eligible committee members no later than at the first committee meeting of the academic year.

Functions

The Curriculum Committee safeguards

- The integrity of academic programs and their curricula,
- The correctness and clarity of the academic contents of the graduate and undergraduate catalogs,
- And the appropriateness of courses accepted into each of the categories of the General Education Program.

The Curriculum Committee recommends

- Actions on undergraduate and graduate proposals (activations, deactivations, and modifications),
- Changes to the undergraduate and graduate curricula,
- And changes to the academic contents of the undergraduate and graduate catalogs.

Procedure

The Committee will meet as often as is deemed necessary by the Chair, but at least twice each semester. A copy of the materials to be reviewed by the Committee will be made available to all members of the Committee.

All recommendations and votes will be recorded in the minutes. The minutes of the Curriculum Committee's meetings will be attached to the agenda of the next Faculty Senate meeting. When the minutes of that particular Faculty Senate meeting are approved, nonpolicy actions take effect.

Proposals to change university policies must be remanded to the proposing faculty member to be submitted to the Faculty Senate to be considered through normal Faculty Senate procedures.
