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Final Exam and Assessment

1 Policy Statement and Purpose

- 1.1 A course's final examination or assessment is designed for evaluating student mastery of course learning objectives.

Any final assessment might include:

- 1.1.1 A traditional examination (including a regular examination given in person during the final examination period),
- 1.1.2 A culminating project,
- 1.1.3 A performance, or
- 1.1.4 Any equivalent assessment appropriate to the discipline.

- 1.2 The specific format of a final assessment shall be determined by the professor and stated in the syllabus. Courses may also include other assessments throughout the term that contribute to the demonstration of student mastery of course learning objectives; such other assessments may replace the final assessment provided they do not conflict with unit requirements.
