The ideal candidate will possess the expertise to teach a variety of core computing courses, such as introductory programming, information systems, e-commerce, system analysis and design, computer architecture, and database systems.

A Ph.D. in Computer Science or a closely related field is preferred, with completion expected by the hire date or within six months thereafter. A strong commitment to excellent teaching is essential. Preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate a record of outstanding teaching, particularly with a diverse student body.

The contract period is for nine months, with a normal teaching load of 12 contact hours per semester.

Additional responsibilities include departmental, college, and university-level service, and maintaining an ongoing scholarship program.

Applications review will begin on September 15th, 2024, and will continue until the position is filled. Final candidates are subject to completing background requirements.
