Preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate a record of outstanding teaching, particularly with a diverse student body.

The contract period is nine months. The normal teaching load is 12 contact hours each semester.

Responsibilities will also include departmental, college, and university-level service and an ongoing scholarship program.

Review of applications will begin on September 15th, 2024, and will continue until the position is filled.

Final candidates are subject to completing background requirements.
