The Position: Lecturer of Business -The College of Business (COB) invites qualified candidates to apply for a non-tenure track Lecturer of Business to start in August 2024.

Minimum Qualifications: Applicants must have a Masters Degree in business or management or a related field or an earned doctorate in a business discipline from an accredited business school. ABDs will be considered.

Knowledge/Skills/Ability: We seek candidates with extensive teaching experience in business and management subjects and the willingness and capability to develop and improve a portfolio of courses in various subjects related to their expertise. Qualified candidates will have excellent communication skills and the ability to work cooperatively with colleagues in a collegial campus community. Preferred candidates will be able to teach a variety of subjects, including but not limited to excel and other computer skills courses, professional development, introduction to business as well as principles of management, and other business-related courses. Candidates will engage and advise a diverse student population. Previous teaching experience including online teaching and online course development is required.

Faculty Responsibilities: This position carries responsibilities in teaching and service. Faculty members typically teach five sections per semester, advise students, serve on university and college committees and engage in professional activities. Teaching assignments will align with the qualifications of the individual and the needs of the college. Candidates must be willing and qualified to teach undergraduate courses in general business as well as other business-related fields in both traditional and online settings. COB faculty teach on the Lander University campus located in Greenwood, South Carolina, and at the University Center Greenville in Greenville, South Carolina. COB faculty teach online courses in the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Bachelor of Applied Science, Bachelor of Arts in Entrepreneurship, and graduate programs. Online teaching experience is preferred. Online teaching faculty must complete an online teaching certification course. Candidates must be willing to serve, as assigned, on both COB committees and Lander University committees. According to AACSB engagement and impact guidelines, COB faculty engage with the local community according to their professional area of expertise. This position requires the academic advising of students.

Salary: Salary commensurate with education and experience.

The College: The College of Business offers a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with seven emphasis areas: Accounting, Financial Services, Health Care Management, Sports Management, Hospitality Management, IT Management, and Management/Marketing.
