NOTE: Effective the 2024-2025 academic year, the parental information required on the FAFSA is based on the parent who provides the greater support for the student. It is not based on who the student lived with most in the last 12 months. If both parents provided an exactly equal amount of financial support during the past 12 months, or if they don't support the student financially, answer the questions about the parent with the greater income and assets.
